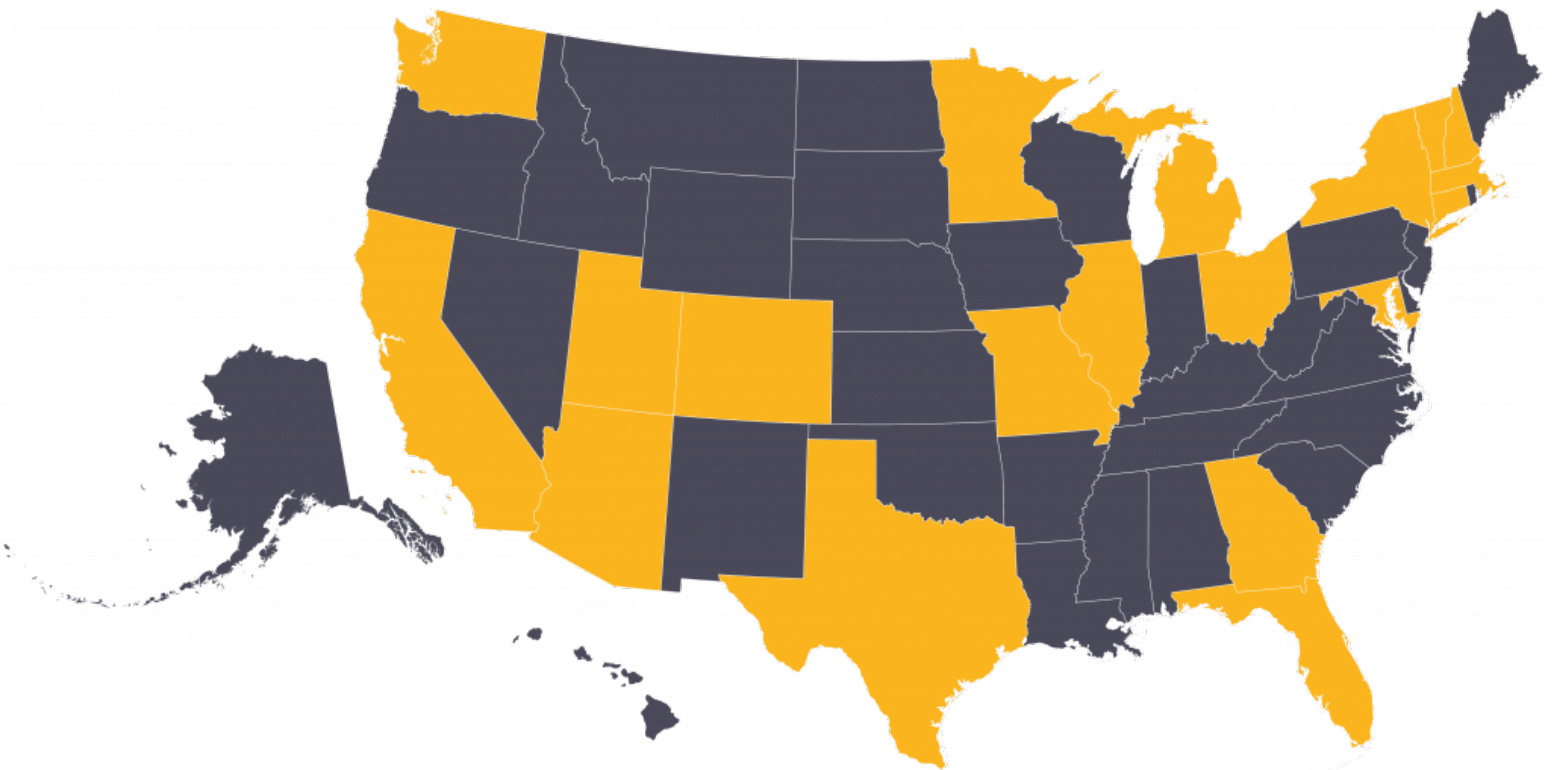

The conference will take place on April 4-5, 2018 at the Grand Hyatt in Denver, Colorado.

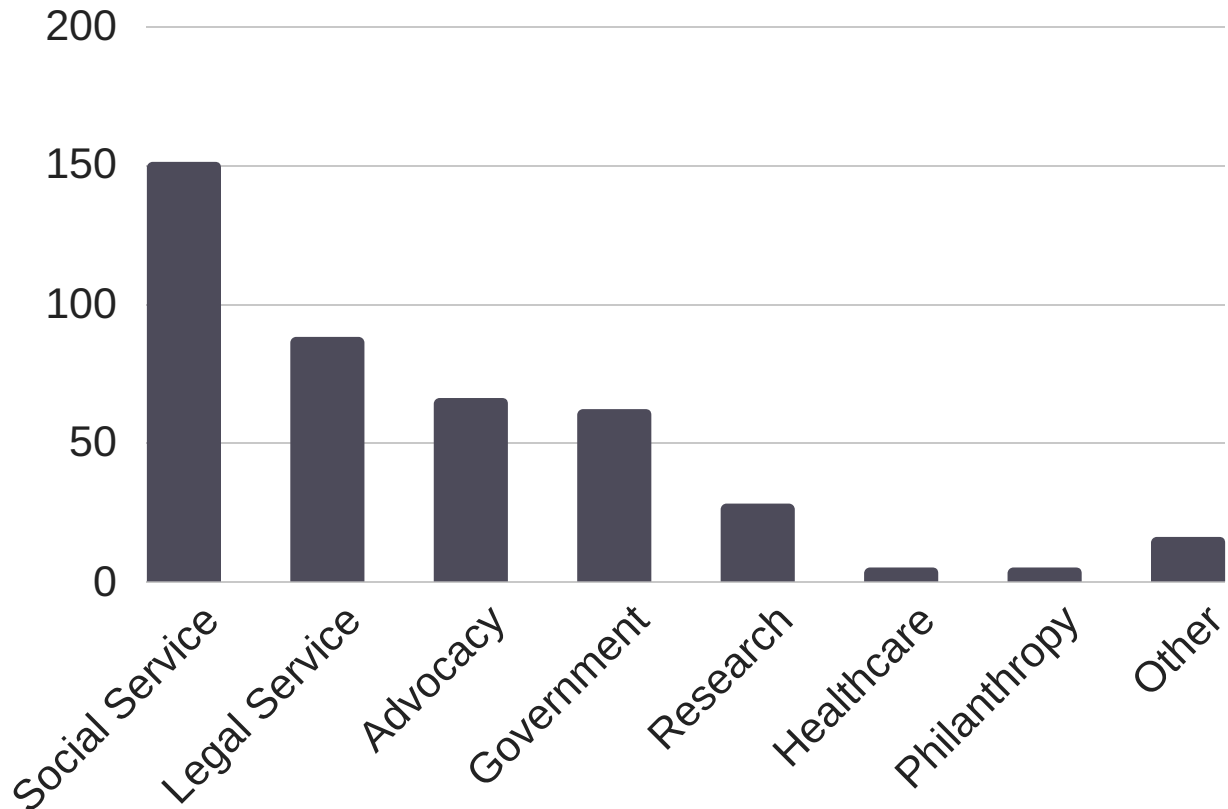

\$1,000 - 2,499
