Job Posting: Part Time Legal Intern- Survivor Reentry Project

Application Deadline: November 19, 2021 or until filled

Position Term: January- May 2022, with possibility of continuation

Location: Washington DC (remote employment possible)

Mission: Freedom Network USA (FNUSA) is the nation's largest alliance of organizations and individual advocates working with survivors of all forms of human trafficking to ensure that trafficked persons have access to justice, safety, and opportunity. FNUSA's Survivor Reentry Project (SRP) is a national clearinghouse and referral network for criminal legal system relief for survivors of human trafficking who have been arrested for crimes related to their victimization. SRP offers technical assistance, training, and a network of pro bono lawyers to represent survivors at the state and local level.

Position Summary: The Legal Intern will respond to requests for assistance from survivors and advocates; coordinate training and technical assistance; and ensure that case status updates are current for all survivors served by the project. This is a part-time, Spring semester internship, with potential for part-time or full-time work during the summer, and reports to the Executive Director (ED).

Essential Job Functions:

- Collaborate with SRP staff and consultants to provide human trafficking survivors with complete legal intakes and direct representation from pro bono partners
- Respond to requests for technical assistance and training in collaboration with SRP staff
- Ensure database is current and complete
- Support SRP staff and consultants to provide training sessions on criminal record relief and SRP

Skills and Qualifications

- Ability to work independently
- Organization and ability to prioritize among multiple tasks
- Experience working with survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, or other forms of trauma, required
- Full-time or part-time law school students only, preference for those who have completed at least one year of law school

Compensation: FNUSA will support the intern's application for academic credit. If academic credit is not available, compensation is \$20.00 per hour. Benefits are not provided for FNUSA interns.
