## **Completing the Fingerprint Process With SRP**

We understand that for many survivors, completing fingerprints can be difficult. For this reason, we ask that you consider doing at least one of these things:

- 1. Attend the appointment with a support person (trusted friend or family member, advocate, case manager, etc.).
- 2. Advise the support person of the scheduled fingerprint appointment and meet or call them afterwards to process your feelings.
- 3. Schedule a call with the SRP Advocate afterwards to process your feelings. She is available to help and support you.
- 4. Do something positive that calms your nervous system (take a nature walk, draw or paint, sing or dance, color, journal, or whatever grounds you).

## **Please Note:**

A third-party company, <u>Printscan</u>, will process your fingerprints and provide your criminal record report.

Printscan has no affiliation with the police.

Requesting your fingerprints will not prompt the police or any other law enforcement agency to contact or locate you.

The person facilitating fingerprinting doesn't know the reason you are requesting your records.

The person facilitating the fingerprint doesn't have access to your background and will not see your results.
