
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Survivor Reentry Project

Survivor Reentry Project Intake Form

Start by introducing yourself and providing a brief explanation about your role in intake. Before Intake, you should go over the consultation agreement with the client, sign the agreement, and send it to the client for signature.

Please let the survivor know that during the call you will be asking some personal questions related to their trafficking experience. Suggest, that they be in a private area during the call if possible and advise they are welcome to stop at any time if questions feel activating.
