Preparing for the SRP Intake Process

This form will provide you with details on how to prepare for your Survivor Reentry Project (SRP) Intake. If you are unable or unwilling to complete an SRP Intake, please follow up with the SRP Advocate to explore alternative options.

Purpose of the Intake

The goal of the Intake is to collect information about your trafficking experience that will assist the Intake Team in determining your eligibility for criminal record relief. The analysis report will include a brief outline of your trafficking experience, a copy of your criminal record, and an analysis of your eligibility for criminal record relief for each item on your criminal record. The report will be discussed with you and a copy will be shared with you via email. The report will also be shared with any assigned legal representation to give them a basic overview of your story.

Before the Call

We understand that for many having to recount and share details about your trafficking experience can be activating. For this reason, we recommend that you:

- Review the questions before the call.
- Plan to meet with a trusted support person before or after the Intake call to help calm you or process your feelings.*
- If you don't have a trusted support person, please contact the SRP Advocate to request their attendance at the intake call.
- If you feel activated after the call, please engage in some positive self-care** activities that calm your nervous system.
- *Trusted support person: Trusted friend, family member, advocate, case manager, counselor, etc.
- **If you need resources for self-care activities please contact the SRP Advocate.

During the Call

The Intake call is expected to last for at least an hour. During the call, you will be asked to share details regarding your trafficking experience. You get to decide how much detail you want to share with the Intake Team. You can pause or end the call at any time, just let the Intake Team know that you need a break, and when you want to talk next. It may take more than one call to complete the Intake.

After the Call

The Intake Team will complete the Report and schedule a call including SRP Staff to discuss the Report and next steps. Please allow up to 3 weeks for the Report to be completed. The Intake Team and SRP Staff will discuss the different types of relief options that may be available and answer any questions you may have.
